Individual Training – ongoing daily:

Desensitization

HRD & Live find

Reading - keep familiar with industry standards - NASAR, SDONA, other SAR groups, case studies, University studies, and dog behavior and training.

Considerations/Activities:

*HRD – surface, buried (include decoy holes with soil disturbance but absolutely no HR) – bury minimum 1 hour prior to exercise, elevated (include on top of structures), shoreline, off shore...include blanks and proof to medical gloves and rewards/food.

*Live find – single subject, multiple subjects, one or both subjects moving, covered subject, subject inside object (vehicle, barrel, shed, etc)...do not forget working blanks.

*Both HRD & live find in same segment...record what default tends to be.

*Agility/obstacles/directionals – whistle and clicker reinforcement

*Boat work if possible – large, small, raft, kayak (inflatable & hard shell)

*Recertification practice

*Other events
